

GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 6:39-45

The gospel passage contains very familiar material that can easily be taken for granted. Again, we see here the poet in Jesus who uses the common technique of Semitic exaggeration to make a point: How can you hope to take a splinter out of someone's eye when your own sight is blocked by a plank? This is an indictment on a person rushing to pass judgment on another – the hypocrite. The Greek word hypokrites actually means 'play-actor', one who plays a part that is not their true self, a dissembler and, by extension, a fake, Jesus really says, 'You fake! First clean up your own act before you point at other people's faults.' Remember the wise and humble answer Pope Francis gave when he was asked for his opinion of gay people, 'Who am I to judge?'

In His reference to the kind of fruit that is produced by good and bad trees in the orchard, Jesus draws attention to what lies within each of us. Here is a parallel to our speech or conversation. Our actions reveal our inner disposition just as our speech does. Loosely quoting Gandhi: We are the product of our thoughts; what we think, we become. What lies within us comes out in our attitudes, actions and speech. If we are cultivating an inner spirituality based on wholesome values, then that will be evident in our behaviour and our relationships.

Being mindful of our world and the people we live with, work with and engage in our daily pursuits, being serious about the quality of reading we undertake, taking time to reflect, are all activities that can foster a quality interior life. If we have no inner life we risk falling prey to the distractions around us. It is so important that we care for our minds as the gateway to caring for our inner selves. After all, we are the product of our choices.

On Friday last week I started the day by turning the sod for a new school at Flagstone, St Bonaventure's College, and ended the day by celebrating the 150 years of another school, St Joseph's College Gregory Terrace. This was Catholic education past and future in this part of the world. St Bonaventure's will be a very different school from Terrace, but it will be part of the same enterprise that began when three young Irish Christian Brothers began teaching twenty-six students in what is now the Chapel next to the Cathedral. Since then the seed they planted has flourished in ways they could never have imagined. Catholic education in Brisbane has changed dramatically over the years, and it will continue to change. But one thing that never changes is that in our schools Jesus will walk the corridors and enter the classrooms to teach the young what it really means to be a human being. That's the great lesson and adventure which awaits everyone in our schools as they set forth into 2025. Travel well!


