RITE OF ELECTION 2026:

The Rite of Election 2026 in the Archdiocese of Brisbane will be celebrated in the Cathedral of St Stephen on the First Sunday of Lent, 22 February, at 3:00 pm.

Important Information About The Rite of Election –

Who comes? Catechumens (those who will be baptised, confirmed & receive Eucharist at Easter); Candidates for Reception into the Catholic Church. (While the Rite of Election is for catechumens, those preparing for reception into the Catholic Church and who were received during the year stand with the baptised and support the catechumens.) Candidates will be acknowledged and prayed for during the liturgy; Sponsors, godparents, catechists, parish priests, parish RCIA team members, and the families and friends of the catechumens and candidates.

What happens? The ceremony begins with a Liturgy of the Word. After the homily, the rite unfolds in two distinct movements, reflecting the different journeys of Candidates for Reception and Catechumens.

1. Candidates for Reception into Full Communion
2. Rite of Election of Catechumens
3. Conclusion of the Rite

What do we bring? The parish Book of the Elect. Make sure it is worthy of the occasion! Food & drink for afternoon tea on the lawns after ceremony. A coffee van will be present. St Paul's Catholic Parish, Woodridge RCIA coordinator is Tess V-Kessels on 0409 618 956.

GOSPEL REFLECTION: Matthew 3:13-17

This passage is Matthew's version of Jesus undergoing John's ritual washing as the sign of a change of heart. John had been preaching that the time of the Messiah's coming was at hand and that people needed to prepare themselves for this by smartening up their lives and doing away with whatever did not gel with a commitment to God. John invited the people who listened to him to come forward into the Jordan River and be dipped or immersed in the water. We have to give John credit for using a familiar Jewish cleansing ritual to give people a physical experience of their decision to turn back to their God.

The Greek verb used by Matthew, Mark and Luke for 'dip' or 'duck' is *baptizein*, from which we get baptize and baptism. But to speak of the 'baptism of Jesus' seems to suggest that He submitted to sacramental baptism, which, of course, had not been instituted or set up at this stage. In effect, Jesus was endorsing John's ritual as a physical symbol of being washed from sin and a return to the Lord.

In both the Hebrew of the Jewish Scriptures, and Aramaic, the language of Jesus and His Jewish contemporaries, repentance is viewed as primarily as a return to God.

The full impact of this event is described by Matthew as a Spirit experience, Jesus emerges from the water with His own inspired gut-feeling that He is called to embark on a prophetic mission. – Laurie Woods

Designed to be used by individuals and in small groups, each day offers a reflection on the Gospel and prompts for your personal reflection.

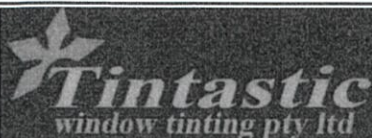
