#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 13:1-9**

This reading opens with a response from Jesus about the Galileans who were murdered at Pilate's orders. The 1st century Jewish historian, Josephus, tells us that Pilate was a ruthless administrator, and a contemporary Hellenistic Jewish philosopher, Philo of Alexandria, wrote that Pilate governed by bribery, insults, executions without trial and great cruelty. Pilate was actually dismissed by Rome in 37 AD for his cruelty.

As part of His reply Jesus used the incident to stress to His listeners the importance of looking into their attitudes and behaviour to see what needed correction. The background of His remarks is the traditional Jewish thought that disaster follows sinfulness. So, He asked His listeners if those who met with fatal accidents and untimely death were being punished for their sins. He was saying that it is impossible to judge that such victims were any worse than those around them.

The book's main argument is that suffering and good fortune have nothing to do with what people deserve or not. It trashes the old belief that bad people suffer while good people prosper. This is too naïve and life just isn't like that. And this is exactly what Jesus is spotlighting here and His conclusion is: look to your own life and see what needs improvement through change.


