VALE POPE FRANCIS:

Pope Francis died yesterday, Easter Monday, at his residence in the Vatican's Casa Santa Marta. He was 88 years old. Pope died after stroke followed by heart failure. Source: Vatican News.

At 9:45 am local time (5:45 pm AEST), Cardinal Kevin Farrell, the Holy See's camerlengo, announced the Pope's death with these words:

"Dearest brothers and sisters, with deep sorrow I must announce the death of our Holy Father Francis. At 7:35 this morning (3:45 pm AEST), the Bishop of Rome, Francis, returned to the house of the Father. His entire life was dedicated to the service of the Lord and of His Church. He taught us to live the values of the Gospel with fidelity, courage, and universal love, especially in favour of the poorest and most marginalised. With immense gratitude for his example as a true disciple of the Lord Jesus, we commend the soul of Pope Francis to the infinite merciful love of the One and Triune God."

The Pope was admitted to the Agostino Gemelli Polyclinic Hospital on February 14, after suffering from a bout of bronchitis for several days. Pope Francis' clinical situation gradually worsened, and his doctors diagnosed bilateral pneumonia on February 18. After 38 days in hospital, the Pope returned to his Vatican residence at the Casa Santa Marta to continue his recover. In April 2024, Francis approved an updated edition of the liturgical book for papal funeral rites, which will guide the funeral Mass, which has yet to be announced. The second edition of the *Ordo Exsequiarum Romani Pontificis* introduces several new elements, including how the Pope's mortal remains are to be handled after death. According to Archbishop Diego Ravelli, Master of Apostolic Ceremonies, Pope Francis had requested that the funeral rites be simplified and focused on expressing the faith of the Church in the Risen Body of Christ.

GOSPEL REFLECTION: John 20:19-31

This Gospel passage is read every year on the Second Sunday because it recounts the events of the evening of Easter Day and also of its octave, that is today. Here Jesus' disciples encounter the Risen Lord, and after a week, so too does Thomas who was not there on Easter Sunday evening.

The fledgling community is filled with the Spirit and commissioned to continue the ministry of Christ. The Risen Christ is in their midst. But then, as now, this presence remains something of a mystery. It is not like a person who wakes up from a coma. Yes, the disciples can see and Thomas can touch His wounds. This is not an apparition; He is real. And yet He is able to stand among them with a greeting of peace even though the doors were locked. We say "seeing is believing" but there is more here than meets the eye.

The encounter with the Risen Lord is transformative. The disciples move from fear to astonishment to joy when they see the Lord. Thomas moves from his refusal to believe to faith and veneration. The challenge for us who hear the Gospel is the same. John concludes his narrative by saying that he has written all these things down *so that you too may believe that Jesus is the Christ... and have life through His name.*

Can our proclamation of the text at Mass achieve this exalted purpose for the assembly?
