GOSPEL REFLECTION: John 21:1–19

The disciples agree to put out a boat and go fishing on the Sea of Galilee and this takes us back to the catch when Jesus said that following would mean they would be bringing in people instead of fish. The huge catch symbolises their later missionary success in response to Jesus' call to put out their nets.

Full and uplifting recognition was complete when the disciples joined Jesus in the meal He had prepared. This, of course, depicted the importance of the community meal that would occupy a central place in the life of Christians. Christ present with them in the thanksgiving meal was the defining core of community.

The difficult and possibly even painful exchange between Jesus and Peter goes to the heart of our relationship with Christ and our relationship with others. The pastoral office assigned to Peter is a model of the pastoral care that might be exercised by anyone in the Christian community. And this is a role that is motivated by love, love for Christ and love for members of the body of Christ.
