### GOSPEL REFLECTION: Mark 4:26-34

This 'seed' parable seems to be Jesus way of demonstrating how powerful the sowing of the message and values of the reign of God are. Jesus has sown the seed and then lets it germinate and grow to completion, which is commitment to God's values on the part of those who hear the Word. A significant theme in Luke's Acts of the Apostles is the almost miraculous power of the Holy Spirit to work the wonder of conviction and dedication in the lives of people who respond positively to the missionary activity of the Apostles and their co-workers.

If people commit to living by the teachings of Jesus then God will ensure that they achieve their potential as whole human beings. Human effort will play a big part but the fulfilment is up to God. On the other hand if there is no human effort to strive for goodness and integrity then there will be no growth at all.

The second parable in this reading is the familiar parable of the mustard seed. It is a tiny seed that has the potential to grow into a large bush in which birds can build their nests. This picks up the reference in the first reading to the mighty cedar that grows and matures from a small cutting. The point is, who can calculate what might emerge from tiny insignificant beginnings? How do I take stock of my potential as an intelligent human being? Am I securely on the road to developing my gifts and talents in such a way that I can become the person I am meant to be?

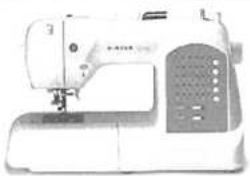
