GOSPEL REFLECTION: Mark 5:21-24, 35-43

Today's gospel passage is a good example of how Mark 'sandwiches' a healing story in the middle of a longer account. By falling on his knees at the feet of Jesus the synagogue leader, Jairus, is not only showing deep respect but also desperation. His daughter is dying and his one last cry for help goes to Jesus. We are aware that he has faith to believe Jesus can heal her. Jesus agrees to go to his home.

On the way, we meet a woman who was afflicted with an abnormal genital haemorrhage that rendered her ritually impure. For a pious Jew this would matter and cause concern. She believes she can remain anonymous and be cured simply by touching the cloak of this Holy Man. She felt instantly better and Jesus became aware of the cure. He turned to ask who touched Him and Peter pointed out that people were pressing in on Him so how could He say someone had touched Him. The woman owned up and fell at His feet admitting what she had done.

Her fear was based on the fact that she had made Jesus ritually unclean by touching His clothes and so she might well expect a blast of indignation. But His reply was anything but. Addressing her in Aramaic as *brati* = My daughter, He shows connection, relationship, and bids her to go now in wholeness. Most of our translations read, 'Go in peace' but the Aramaic *shlama*, like the Hebrew *shalom*, comes from the root verb *shlm* which means to be whole, finished, rounded off, complete. It means that peace is seen, not so much as the absence of conflict, but as the by-product of being whole and mature – integrated in mind and spirit.
